USD #374 Part-Time Student Policy

HB 2567 ~ Part-Time Enrollment

The bill requires school districts to allow for the part-time enrollment of students who are also enrolled in a private or homeschool. Each board of education of a school district must adopt a policy to allow such students to enroll and attend any courses, programs, or services offered by the school district.

If school districts receive specific scheduling request from part-time enrolled students, the bill requires the school district to make a good faith attempt to accommodate such request, but the bill would not require such school district to accommodate all requests.

Part-Time Student Policy/Requirements

1. Part-time students will be required to meet and are subject to all USD #374 student policies. These include, but are not limited to; district attendance policies, district dress code policies, and student behavior/discipline policies.

2. Part-time students are required to attend school/classes regularly. State truancy policies will be enforced.

3. Classes will be on campus only.

4. Part-time students must be enrolled in at least five classes in order to participate in all school activities that **may include but are not limited to**; prom, school dances, be eligible for king and queen nominations, hold class offices, participate in school voting, school clubs, and/or organizations, athletics, team activities, senior recognition nights, etc.

5. As per the KSHSAA policy, virtual part time students must be enrolled in one brick and mortar class, as well as four virtual classes that are with a KSDE approved accredited virtual school.

6. If the class the student is enrolled in requires activities outside of the school day and are part of their grade (concerts, meetings, etc.), students will be required to attend such activities. As per the eligibility policy, students may not participate in these activities if they are ineligible. In that event, the teacher will assign the student an alternative assignment to allow the student to earn the points or will exempt the activity from their grade.

7. Part time students must have attended USD #374 for one calendar year if in grades 9-12 and for eighteen weeks if in grades PreK-8 to be eligible to participate in activities.

8. Participation fees will not be prorated. Part time students will pay the same fees as full time students.

9. All part time student requirements may be waived at any time and is at the discretion of the administration.
