

## **USD 374 Non-Resident Student Policy**

USD 374 has established the following criteria regarding HB2567. If a student wishes to re-enroll at USD 374 and meets one of the following criteria they will be deemed “not in good standing” and may be denied enrollment. A non-resident student is defined as a student that wishes to re-enroll at a school district, but does not reside within the boundaries of that school district.

- 1.) The non-resident student failed to maintain a 90% attendance rate within the previous calendar year at their previous school. Excused absences shall not be factored into the 90% attendance rate.
- 2.) The non-resident student and/or guardian provided false information during the application process.
- 3.) The non-resident student is not a resident of Kansas.
- 4.) The non-resident student is currently under a period of suspension or expulsion from any Kansas School District.
- 5.) The non-resident student had 3 or more office referrals for behavior within a calendar year.
- 6.) The non-resident student had an out-of-school suspension within a calendar year.
- 7.) The non-resident student was given a long-term suspension or expulsion by any Kansas School District within a calendar year.
- 8.) The non-resident student had 8 or more unexcused tardies in a semester.
- 9.) The non-resident student must be working at grade level and on track to graduate with his or her cohort group.

\*Parents/guardians shall be informed of the administration's decision to allow or not allow enrollment within 5 business days.

\*USD 374 Administration reserves the right to modify or amend any of the above stipulations at any time.
